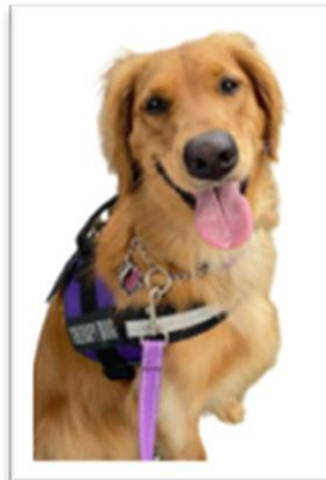


Meet Our Therapy Dogs
